SCOPE: All potential collectors and submitters of BAL samples to the laboratory for processing.

I. DEFINITION:

Bronchial alveolar lavage is a diagnostic procedure used to obtain a sample of cells and secretions from the alveolar and bronchial airspaces in the lungs. This fluid is then submitted to the Laboratory for testing to help diagnose infections in patients.

II. COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS:

- A. All samples should be hand delivered to the Laboratory within 30 minutes of collection.
- B. Volume Requirements:

Call laboratory prior to collection to validate any volumes that are not within the guide below. Fill all luken traps to the bottom nozzle. This should be sufficient volume to perform the following test.
